

DOMÉ 4.0 marketplace ecosystem: Explore tab

Keywords/actions: search, browse

For whom: User who wants to run a search or browse the assets that are currently available (that is, registered or uploaded) on DOMÉ 4.0 or *via* DOMÉ 4.0

In brief: The explore tab lists buttons to either 1) run a search (“Search” and “Advanced search” buttons) or 2) browse the currently available assets (“Data sources”, “Tools and services”, “Ontologies” buttons). “Available on DOMÉ 4.0” here means registered (e.g., for the case of API connectors to external data sources) or uploaded (e.g., for the case of an ontology). 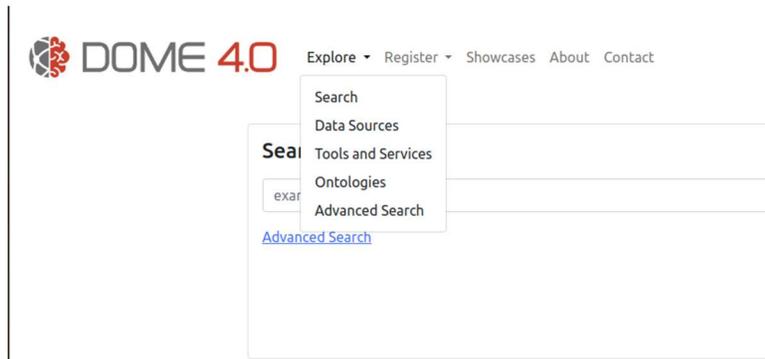


Figure: Snapshot of DOMÉ 4.0 main page, after login, hovering on the “Explore” tab

More details:

- The standard Search is a text-based search and acts on all the fields of the Data Sources and Catalog Data (See also [Register tab, Search](#))
- The Advanced Search is an RDF-based search and acts over the uploaded ontologies/knowledge graphs: it functions like a simplified SPARQL query, that is, it looks in the stored graph for given patterns of type “subject-predicate-object”, where one or more of the parts (e.g., the subject) are specified by the user (See also [Register tab, Advanced Search](#)).
